6. Noise Regulation Exemption Certificate – Johan Strydom		
6.1. From time-to-time heritage aircraft operators wish to fly into and operate from Jandakot Airport. To do this the operator must obtain a noise regulation exemption certificate which requires consultation with the relevant airports and council. 6.2. The aircraft is a 1941 Boeing Stearman open cockpit biplane operating under the administration of Australian Warbirds. 6.3. It is anticipated that these flights may occur 2 – 3 times a year. 6.4. Consideration will be given to re-addressing this if the flight numbers increase substantially 6.5. Majority of the members present at the meeting and previously via email have expressed no objection. 6.6. Winthrop Residents Group will support their operation if the following occurs:		
6.6.1. Agree to fly over South Street, O'Connor industrial area, and Fremantle golf course. 6.6.2. Will adhere to the voluntary fly neighbourly procedure		

6.7. S. Klomp stated it is important to note that the committee cannot enforce requirements onto an operator or prevent the flights taking place. 6.8. The operator (J. Strydom) has agreed to the request and will confirm this in writing with the clause: direction from ATC will always take precedence and will always operate within the published VFR routes.
